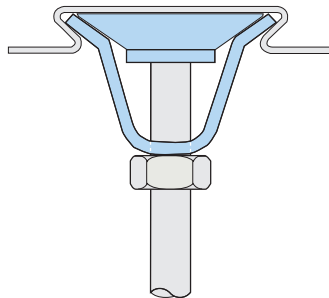
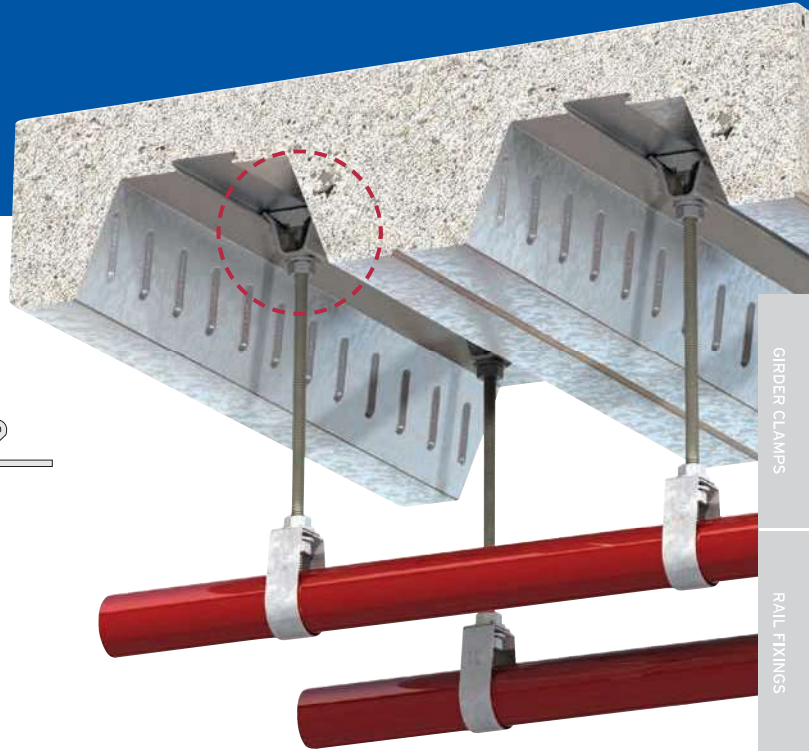


Type MW2 - Multiwedge 2

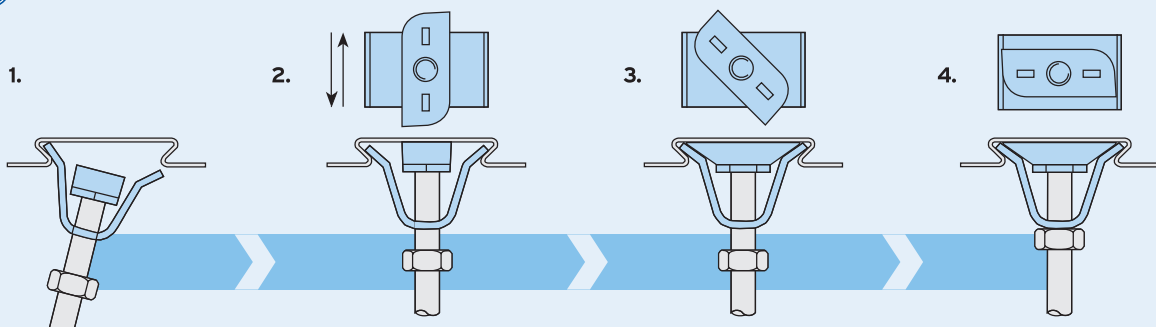

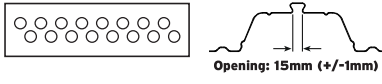








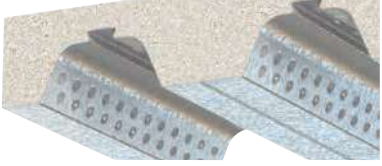




















- 1) Pre-assemble the bracket and wedge (flat surface facing up) onto the threaded rod and insert one side of the bracket into the re-entrant channel of the decking.
- 2) Click the other leg of the bracket into position inside the decking and slide the assembly to the desired position along the length of the re-entrant channel.
- 3) Push and turn the wedge clockwise until it locks into the channel walls.
- 4) Tighten the hexagon nut beneath the assembly to the tightening torque specified in the table above.

- ▶ Install the decking fixings after the concrete has been poured and has reached full strength.
- ▶ If the decking profile is deformed or distorted, do not install the fixing. If in doubt, contact the Technical Support team for advice.
- ▶ Although the Type MW2 is similar in appearance to Type MF (p. 72), it should NOT be used in profiles manufactured by CMF®.

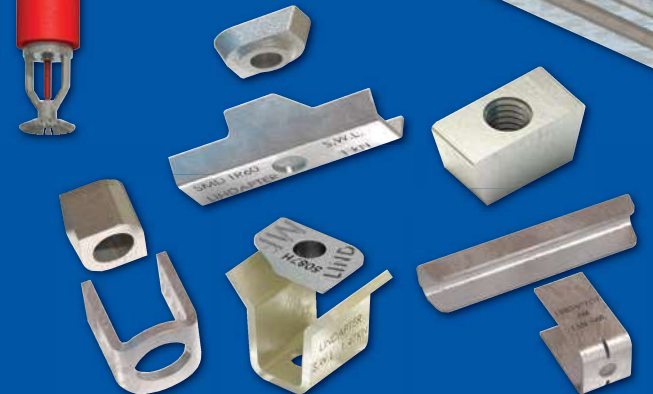
This innovative technique provides an adjustable fixing point for suspending mechanical and electrical equipment that is fast to install and does not compromise the strength of the deck.

Non-Combustible Materials

Lindapter's decking fixings are manufactured from steel and iron which are listed in Commission Decision 96/603/EC as materials that make 'no contribution to fire' and are considered as Class A1 Reaction to Fire Performance without the need for additional fire safety testing.

Independently Fire Tested

To provide specifiers with additional confidence, Lindapter commissioned BRE Global to run third party fire tests in accordance with BS EN 1991-1-2 on a range of Decking Fixings installed in concrete backed composite decking profiles. BRE test reports **P116310 Issue 1**, **P123815-1001 Issue 1** and **P123815-1001 Issue 1.1** verify load limits for 60, 90 and 120 minute fire ratings.

 **Performance class A1 in accordance with 96/603/EC**
